Putting conchos on your

Nurtural bridle

- 1.** Putting conchos on your bridle can give it that western look. This is an easy project that anyone can do. You need a few supplies first.



Leather lacing or shoelaces, preferably in your bridles colour. You need two, one for each side and they need to be at least a foot long.

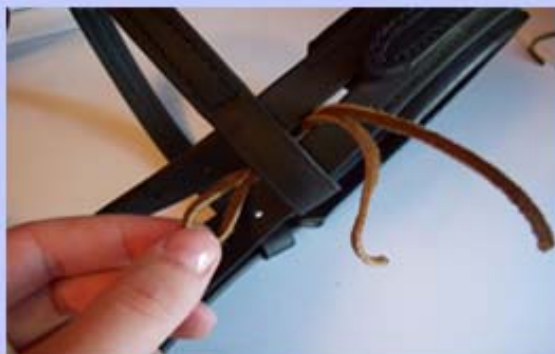
Two conchos. You can purchase them at most craft stores. Your nurtural bridle. Beads are optional but add a little security.

- 2.** Remove the bridles rosettes or clips.



This can be done by un doing the cheek strap and sliding it out of the brow band. Once you get that out you can slide the rosette or clip off the browband.

3.



Fold the first piece of leather lacing or shoe lace in half and thread it loop first through the top of the browband. Pull it around the back until it looks something like the picture to the left.

4.



Put the loop through one side of the concho and the two ends through the other. The two loose ends should hang down if you have done this correctly. You can add beads and tie little knots in the end of the strings if you want.

A finished, now more western looking nurtural bridle!
